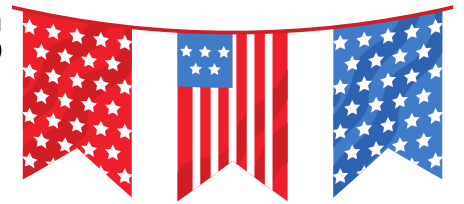

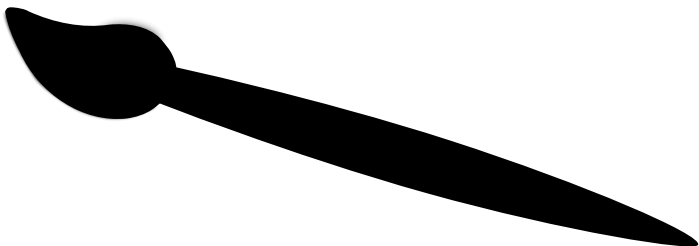

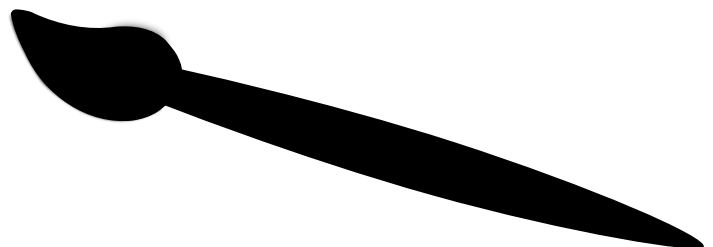

Located on the Comanche National Grassland south of La Junta, Colorado, these primitive canyons are home to the largest dinosaur track site in North America!

Tour: This is an all day tour from 8:00am - 4:00pm. BY RESERVATION ONLY.

Admission: Tours are offered through the Recreation Fee

Demonstration Program of the USDA Forest Service. The cost is \$15 per adult and \$7.50 per child. Due to rough roads, visitors will need their own four-wheel drive high clearance vehicle.

Guided auto tours are the easiest way to experience Picketwire Canyonlands & learn about its rich, colorful past. During the tour, knowledgeable guides will show you difficult to find dinosaur tracks, & the interesting prehistoric, historic, & natural features of the canyons.

This auto tour is the only motorized access into the canyons. Other ways to visit include hiking, mountain biking, or horseback riding.

Because of the rugged terrain & long distances to various sites, these visitors need to plan carefully for hot weather conditions by carrying ample water & leaving very early.

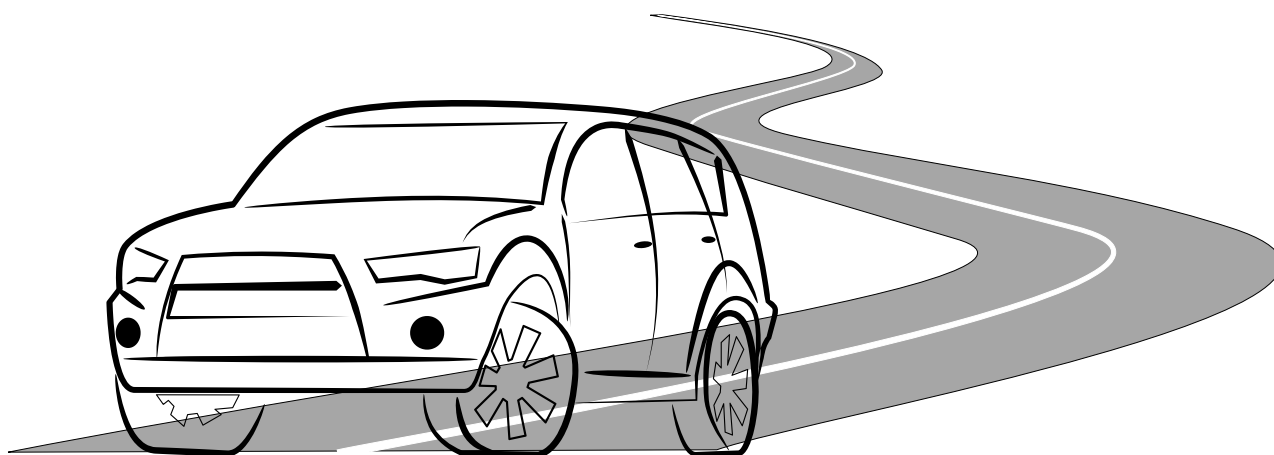

Directions: The drive to Bishop Castle will take you over 9,200 feet above sea level along the Frontier Pathways Scenic & Historic Byway. The easiest way to get to Bishop Castle is from I-25. Take exit #74 at Colorado City & head towards the mountains. (Right off the exit ramp from the north & left off the exit ramp from the south) This puts you on Colorado state highway 165 & its 24 miles without a turn to the Castle. You will see signs for the castle as you come upon it, & there are usually many cars out front.

Bishop Castle is always open & always free! Please respect the castle & the people that live & work here. Please dispose of waste in proper containers. Please keep in mind the Castle is an open construction site - exercise the utmost caution while visiting. Visitors are encouraged to explore the castle on their own as there are no guided tours. The best opportunities to view actual construction on the castle by Mr. Bishop are during weekends. The castle Dragon is fired up on weekends Memorial Day through Labor Day, sometimes with a Bonus Surprise guaranteed to amaze.

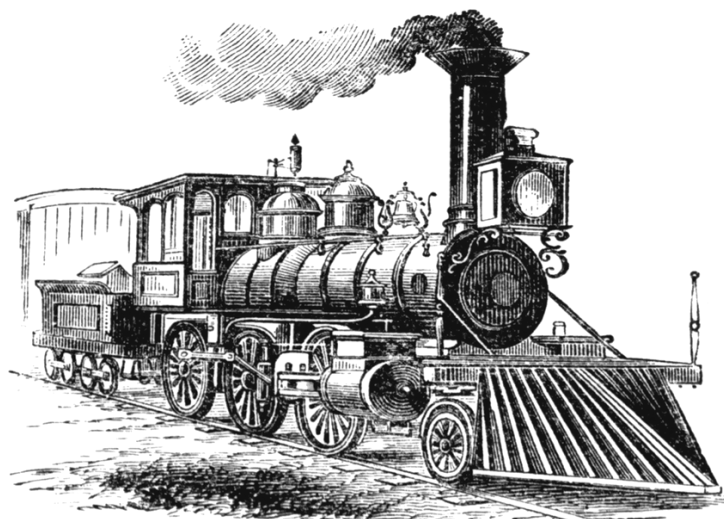

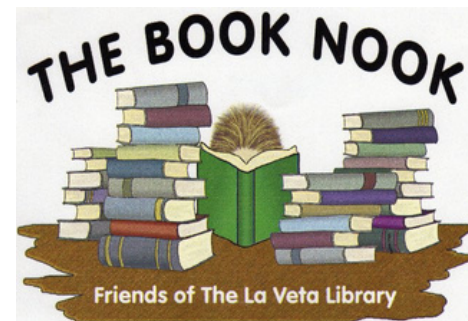

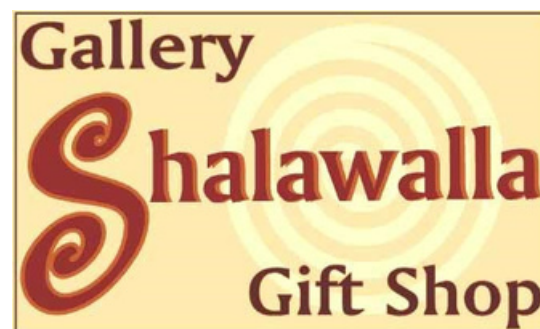
