## **PIE BAKING COMPETITION RULES**

1. Contestants must file an entry form to reserve a spot by July 7, 2025. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED.

2. Pie contestants do not have to pay an admission fee. All others must pay the \$10 admission fee.

3. Pie must be pre-cooked and prepared prior to the competition. All food preparation including toppings, dough making, filling preparation, etc., must be done in a sanitary manner.

4. All ingredients must come from approved sources so that it is safe for public consumption.

5. You must have TWO of the same pie, one for the competition (can be in your own dish), one for the FUNdraiser. The contest pie will be cut into samples, so we encourage bakers to bake their sample pies in a 9x13 (or larger) baking tray. It takes the same amount of crust and ingredients as a pie in a dish, but is far, far easier to cut into samples. The FUNdraiser pie must be in a container you do NOT need to be returned.

6. We encourage the savory auction pies to come frozen. We will keep them frozen during the event.

7. Votes and bids must be in by 6:00 pm. Counting will begin immediately.

8. The votes will be counted and judges will announce the winner of each category by 6:15 pm. Each category will have a first place winner. Prizes and bragging rights will be awarded at this time. Silent auction winners will also be announced at this time and must be present to win.

9. Each contestant is expected to arrive at 4:00 pm to set up their half-table and check in. Each contestant is welcome to make their half-table as attractive as possible to entice the voters. Each contestant must have a sign with their pie name, entry number and category. There will be signs provided by La Veta Public Library.

10. Each contestant must provide their own pie cutting knife and server.

11. Materials and utensils for tasting will be provided by the La Veta Public Library.

12. Drinks will be provided by the La Veta Public Library

13. Those people attending will be given a ticket to vote for their favorite in each of the following categories.

- Best Fruit
- □ Best Sweet (Cream/Chiffon/Meringue/Custard)
- □ Best Savory
